ITEM 1: CALL TO ORDER

Mayor John Rolbiecki called the regular monthly meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

ITEM 2: CALL FOR AGENDA ADDITIONS

The Administrator asked that the following items be added: \$7,693.93 additional bills register.

ITEM 3: ADOPT AGENDA

Koppien motioned, seconded by Rodas, to adopt the agenda as amended with the addition as listed above. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY

ITEM 4: APPROVE MINUTES

The Council reviewed the prior month Council meeting minutes. With no questions or additional comments Teigland motioned, seconded by Koppien to approve the March 13, 2017 Regular Council meeting minutes. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY

ITEM 5: REPORTS AND UPDATES

(5a) - The Council reviewed the April 4, 2017 Police report as submitted by Chief Bolt; (5b) – the current Financial Report as submitted by Administrator Teigland; (5c) – Y-T-D Budget Status Report; (5d) – The Council also reviewed a letter from Cyndee Gmach, Pay Equity Coordinator, congratulating the City on successfully meeting the requirements of the Local Government Pay Equity Act M.S. 471.991-471.999 and rules Chapter 3920. ITEM 8: SUMMER PART-TIME HELP

Koppien motioned, seconded by Teigland to set the part-time summer help/mower wage to \$11.00 per hour. KOPPIEN, RODAS, ROLBIECKI AND TEIGLAND VOTED YES WITH GILLUND ABSTAINING. MOTION PASSED. If the Council's offer of employment is not accepted the Personnel Committee will review all applications on file, interview potential candidates and return to the Council with their recommendation.

ITEM 9: SUMMER REC DIRECTOR

Teigland motioned, seconded by Koppien to hire Tyson Sonnenburg as Summer Recreation Director for the 2017 season. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY

ITEM 10: POOL EMPLOYEES

Teigland motioned, seconded by Rodas to hire Barb Knutson as Certified Pool Operator, Kim Gades as Head Life Guard and Kalley Kloos as Assistant Head Life Guard. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY

ITEM 11: POOL PASS PRICES

The Council reviewed the current pool pass and swimming lesson prices. No action was taken by the Council. The Administrator will compile a list of area pool prices for the Council's review.

ITEM 12: REHAB LOANS

A request was made of the Council to approve the transfer of the Minneota SCDP Commercial Rehabilitation Program Combination Mortgage & Deferred Loan Agreement between the Bargain Center and the City of Minneota to Randy and Anne DeVries as new owners of the building located at 117 N Jefferson Street. Teigland motioned, seconded by Rodas to approve the transfer of the SCDP Grant/Loan balance, loan agreement & mortgage as recorded on Document No. T13330, May 24, 2011 in the Lyon County Recorder's Office to Randy and Anne DeVries. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY. Teigland motioned, seconded by Gillund to approve the transfer of the SCDP Grant/Loan balance, loan agreement & mortgage as recorded on Document No. 198543, March 1, 2013 in the Lyon County Recorder's Office as Bill Ufkin and Alison Ufkin, a husband and wife, d/b/a Ufkin's Furniture & Appliance of Minneota to Bill Ufkin and Alison Ufkin, a husband and wife, with no deferred loan repayment requirement or penalty to the Borrower. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY
