

Housing Rehab Grant Funds Available in Minneota!

*The **Small Cities Development Program** may be able to help!*

In 2017, the **City of Minneota** was awarded a Small Cities Development Program (SCDP) grant.

What can this program do for our community?

The Minneota SCDP program offers financial assistance to eligible homeowners in the community to assist with necessary repairs, energy efficiency upgrades, and other eligible housing rehab projects.

How is the City of Minneota able to assist homeowners?

With the SCDP program, the **City of Minneota** is able to offer up to \$20,000 per home, in grants and low-interest loans, to eligible homeowners for housing rehab projects such as those listed below.

Why did the City of Minneota apply for this grant program?

The Minneota city council recognizes the importance of well-maintained, safe, and energy-efficient housing for current homeowners and future generations.

How long is this program available in the City of Minneota?

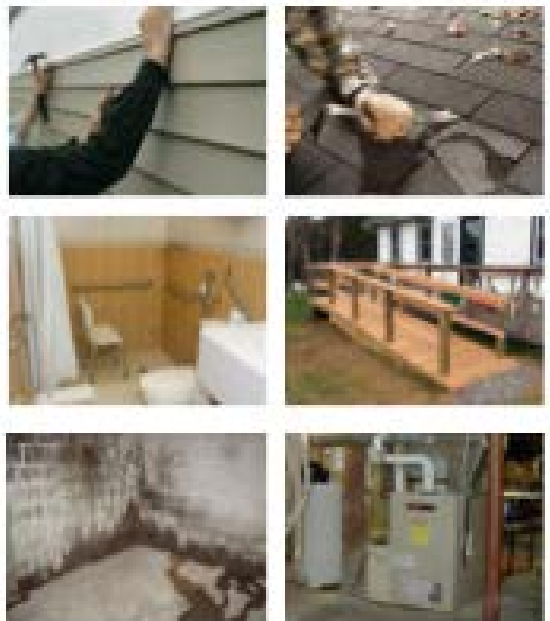
The SCDP program is a 36-month program. In the City of Minneota, this program will no longer be available to Minneota homeowners after December 2019.

Grant Funding Available for:

***Siding – Shingles – Insulation
Foundation cracks – Lead Abatement,
Energy-efficient Windows, Doors, Furnace
Plumbing and/or Electric Upgrades
Ramps or other Handicap Accessible projects***

The SCDP program is made available through Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development. The City of Minneota has selected Development Services, Inc. and their experienced staff to administrator this grant program on their behalf.
